The right place for your small problem waste



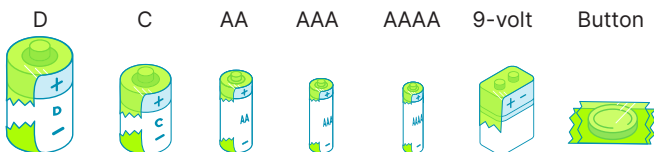
It's FREE to drop off:

Safety tips:

- Carry cracked or corroded batteries individually in a plastic bag
- Wrap the ends of batteries and button batteries in tape

Items NOT accepted at Community Recycling Stations:

- Lithium and lithium-ion batteries
- Car batteries
- Fluorescent tubes
- Broken or leaking globes
- Any accepted item that is larger than the slot

These items should be taken to the Maitland Resource Recovery Facility (109 Mt Vincent Rd, East Maitland). No commercial quantities.
