Ask your child to collect things that are the same colour.

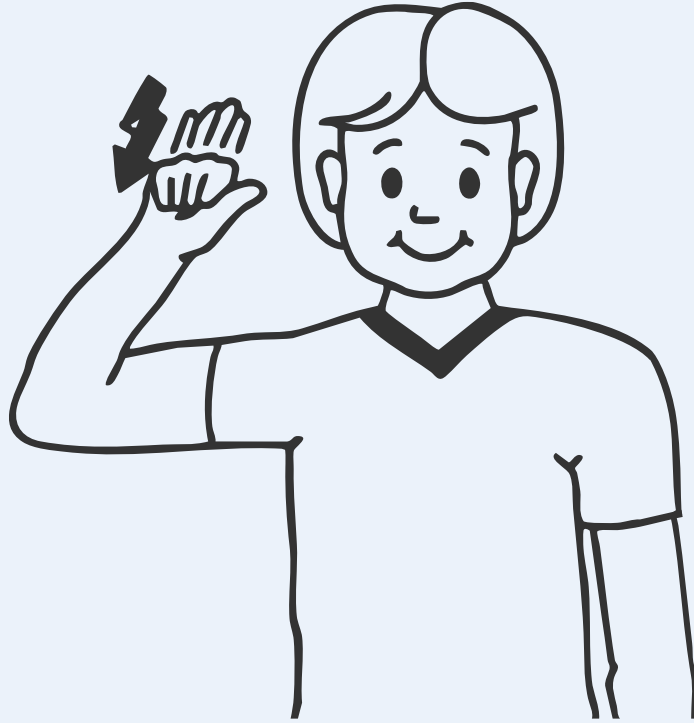
Have fun talking about what they found, the shapes and textures too!
