One, two, three, four, five!



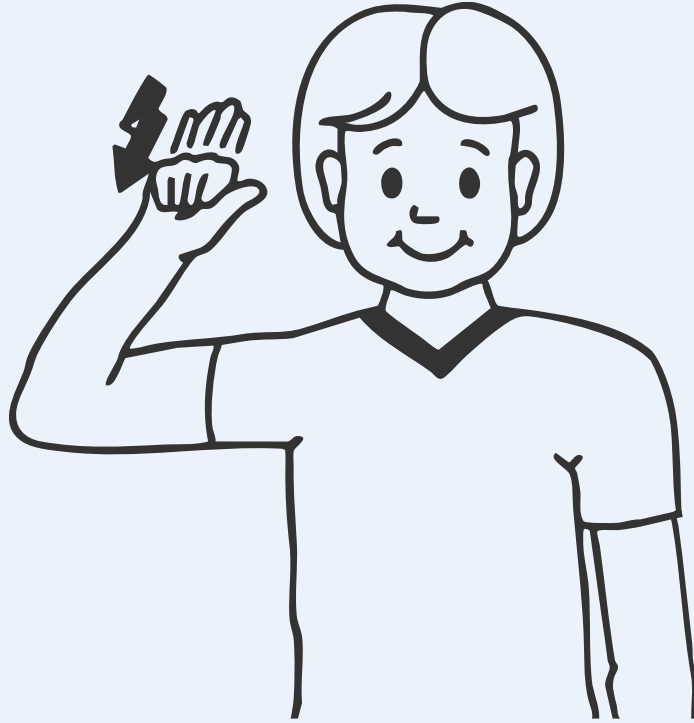
